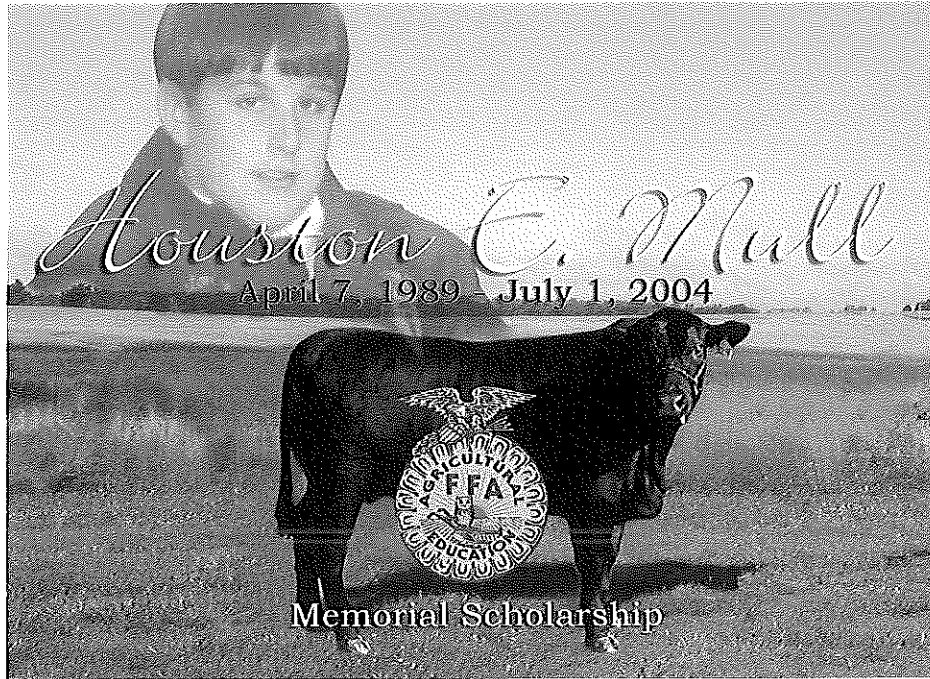


Houston E. Mull FFA Scholarship



Scholarship amounts will vary based on the number of applicants.

Mission Statement: The goal of this scholarship program is to recognize students in an FFA program in Marshall and the surrounding area schools. Students who receive a scholarship must use it to further their education at a two or four year college, university, technical or specialty school.

Eligibility/Criteria: Secondary students must be an FFA member, a high school senior and eligible to graduate the current year for which the award is being made with a GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
